If you are coming from the east:
 From Speedway and Campbell, go west on Speedway to Mountain Ave. Turn left on Mountain Ave.
If you are coming from the west:
 From Interstate 1-10, go east on Speedway and turn right on Mountain Ave. Go south two blocks on Mountain Ave. to Second Street (where Mountain dead ends) and turn left. The parking garage is the first building on your right. FREE parking on the weekends! There will be signs to direct you to the Walk site on the Campus Mall, which is a very short distance, just south of the parking garage. (map available on our website)
